



School Psychologists

Frederick County Public Schools is seeking a School Psychologist to work to identify and assist in implementing reasonable accommodations for individual cognitive, physical, emotional and social needs of our students. The School Psychologist works collaboratively with professional staff and administrators to support quality instruction and help students achieve their fullest potential. The School Psychologist will accomplish this by assessing student skills and by planning and providing academic and social emotional interventions.

Applicants must be eligible for, or hold, a Virginia license with an endorsement in School Psychology; graduate level work including training in psychological and educational testing; experience and skill as an active member of a multi-disciplinary team to support struggling students through a problem-solving process, skill at conducting individual and group counseling sessions with students, experience in the administration and interpretation of psychological and educational diagnostic assessment instruments, skill in explaining evaluative information to staff and parents, and skill with report writing to include prescriptive educational recommendations.

This is an 11 month position (220 days), effective for the 2021-2022 school year.

The salary range is \$54,405 - \$98,404 (salary scale 21-22).
